Dear Friends,

In the early 1960's, Edith Piaf rocked the world of music with her gutsy French rendition of "No Regrets". With her powerful, raspy voice and her unforgettable rolling "rrrrrrs", she shook her musical fist at remorse and sadness. The song struck a chord with the public and immediately became an all-time classic – a liberating declaration of freedom from regret. Why? Because so many of us *do* carry around the terrible burden of regret; regret, not only for the things we shouldn't have done, but also for the things we *should* have done, but didn't. Differences we could have made in someone's life, but failed to because of procrastination, or fear, or lack of initiative.

Some of them are living, as I write, in situations so desperate, as to seem overwhelming. But with God's help we will have *no regrets*.
