


Dear Friend,

A few minutes ago I watched a short video of one of our Kenyan children telling how they were orphaned by AIDS and left at the orphanage in Homa Bay. I had just left a heart breaking conversation with one of our children here at Adullam House, in Alabama, who is deeply scarred from being born addicted to drugs and damaged by parental rejection. I went from there to a Skype call with board members discussing the fact that our homes in Moldova, where we protect teenagers from being trafficked on the streets, **will be fuller this year than they have been for many years.**

ges 16, 13, 9 and 5) are leaving to spend two months in Africa. They will be gathering information (finding out names, ages, medical needs and academic levels) to create files for each of the children. They will be training teachers at the school, and running a VBS with the kids. On June 17th they will be joined by fifteen of our young Adullam House teenagers, staff and volunteers who have raised their own funds to go and minister for two weeks alongside the Harborths in this great mission field.

This coming weekend, Brother Pete Spackman and Brian Paterson will be leaving for **Moldova**, **the poorest country in Europe**. They will be meeting with the Head of Children's Protection Services, overseeing



the transition of house-parents, spending time with the kids and exploring other exciting doors of ministry that are opening to us there. When he returns, Pete will be going on to the Summer-Fire Conference in Cork, Ireland where he will meet and minister with friends from all over the UK and beyond. Many of our interns and much needed help for the work of Adullam House has come from this great conference in Cork - precious, precious friends and partners.

And you too, friend, you have been our ally in this great work that we daily endeavor to accomplish.

From the hurting hearts of the children of incarcerated parents in the U.S., to the starving orphans of Kenya, and the at-risk, abandoned children of Moldova, **God is using Adullam House** to reach out with the wonderful news that Jesus saves to the uttermost!
